Now that you have gone through the Bank PO exam syllabus for respective SBI & IBPS PO Recruitment, it's time to go through the list of topics asked from each section. The Bank PO exam syllabus is similar for almost all the banks, however, some of the differences in the pattern are pointed below -

- The Bank PO Syllabus for SBI, IBPS, IBPS RRB, J&K banks are divided into two parts i.e., Prelims & Mains whereas other banks like Nainital, Canara, BOB, or SIB consist of a single online objective test.
- All three SBI PO, IBPS PO, and J&K Bank PO exams share a similar Prelims & Mains exam pattern.
- You don't need to study Computer Aptitude for the Canara Bank PO exam.
- Bank PO Exam Syllabus share a similar set of Reasoning, Quant, English & GK topics from each section that we have pointed to in the table below.
